RESIDENCY Data Analysis 2018-2019

- NUMBER OF INVESTIGATIONS DONE BY
 - CENTRAL OFFICE = 15
 - PRIVATE INVESTIGATOR = 5

- SCHOOL REFERRALS FOR INVESTIGATIONS MUST HAVE:
 - SCHOOL INVOLVEMENT (PRINCIPAL, SOCIAL WORKER)
 - COMPLETE FORM A from the RESIDENCY Handbook

- CONTINUE TO SEND ALL RESIDENCY VERIFICATION WITH NON-STANDARD DOCUMENTATION TO CENTRAL OFFICE



RESIDENCY Data Analysis

- 153 ELL families have come through the Operations Office for the 2018-2019 SY to verify residency after having been referred to Operations by the Welcome Center or a school. Less than 5 of which have been homeowners.
- 5 existing students (not new to district) have been investigated by the private investigator during the 2018-2019 SY.
- 4 students were determined to have relocated to a new address within Norwalk.
- 1 student was found to be living in Bridgeport and was notified that they would be dis-enrolled. The family has exercised their statute right to present their residency case to a hearing officer designated by the Board of Education. This hearing is scheduled.
- Private Investigator will conduct observations at each of our train stations.

RESIDENCY Data Analysis (ELL) 8/29/18 - 1/15/19

Of the 173 non-kindergarten new ELLs:

- 130 came directly from other countries
- 27 transferred from other school districts within Connecticut.
- 16 transferred from school districts in other states.
- 18 were born in the United States
- 155 were born outside of the United States
