Dear Property Owner/Resident,

This is a friendly reminder that you, as the property owner/resident, are responsible for the removal of snow from any sidewalk that is adjacent to your property.

We have received multiple complaints, citywide, about impassible sidewalks due to snow and ice. This is causing dangerous situations for pedestrians, including school-aged children. We are asking for your help in creating a safer path for those pedestrians.

If you choose not to comply or if this becomes habitual, you could be subject to a fine.

Attached is a brief summary of our city codes regarding sidewalks and city right-of-ways. Please read carefully.

CODE ENFORCEMENT CITY ORDINANCES AND FINE SCHEDULE
FOR
SIDEWALKS AND RIGHT-OF-WAYS

CITY CODE; 21-18

Signs prohibited on utility poles; \$100.00 per sign, per day, per location

CITY CODE; 94-3B

Recycling items & container; Up to \$10,000.00

CITY CODE; 94-5A

Garbage and Recycle cannot be placed at curbside until evening before scheduled pickup;
\$250.00 per day for each violation

CITY CODE; 94-5C

Failure to remove garbage and recycling containers from sidewalk or city right of way after
collection; \$250.00 per day for each infraction

CITY CODE; 94-6

SOLID WASTE; Unlawful deposit of uncollectable trash. Bulk items on sidewalk or city right of
way; \$250.00 per day if not removed by "DUE DATE;"

CITY CODE; 95-3

OBSTRUCTIONS AND NUISANCES; Basketball hoops, H frame/lawn signs on city property;
pushing snow into roadway; \$250.00 per day, per sign, per location

CITY CODE; 95-7

Grass and weeds overgrown; Hedges blocking sidewalks, or causing sightline issues for
motorists; \$100.00 per day if not cleared by "DUE DATE"

CITY CODE; 95-10

Failure to remove snow from sidewalk adjacent to property; \$250.00 per day 24 hours after city
plowing is complete
